Memorandum of Understanding Between

The Macao Special Administrative Region of the People's Republic of China and

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation of the Kingdom of Cambodia
On

Cooperation Framework for Promotion of Friendship

Taking into consideration the traditional friendship between the People's Republic of China and the Kingdom of Cambodia, in accordance with comprehensive strategic partnership of cooperation established by the leaders of the two countries, and in order to further promote the friendly and cooperative relations between the Macao Special Administrative Region of the People's Republic of China and the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation of the Kingdom of Cambodia, in development of economy, trade, tourism, culture, youth affairs and other various fields and for the contribution to pursuing the Belt and Road Initiative. The Macao Special Administrative Region and the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation have agreed to jointly promote and collaborate in the following areas:

- 1. Coordinating and arranging meetings and contacts between the Macao Special Administrative Region and the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation in order to strengthen non-government and official exchanges and cooperation.
- 2. Stepping up the efforts on exchanges and cooperation on training in tourism studies and cultural heritage protection, for the benefit to promote Macao as a "World Tourism and Leisure Center" and to enhance the development of Cambodia in related fields.
- 3. Strengthening the function of Macao as being a service platform for economic and trade cooperation between China and Portuguese-speaking countries and promoting agricultural products of Cambodia venturing into Portuguese-speaking countries.
- 4. Organizing the "Belt and Road Initiative Visit Program" and providing opportunities for the mutual learning and practices to the youth, business associations and students of Macao and Cambodia through the exchange program.
- 5. Increasing the number of quotas for the Belt and Road Scholarship for Cambodian students, established by the Macao Foundation.
- 6. This MOU shall come into force from the date of its signature. Amendments, extensions or termination to this MOU shall be discussed by both Parties and made in writing.

This MOU is signed in Phnom Penh, Kingdom of Cambodia on 07 May 2018, and it is done in three copies in Chinese, Khmer and English. All texts being equally authentic.
